






PSE	<p>Create a poster to display 5 rules for a healthy and happy friendship.</p> <p>What qualities do you admire in your friends?</p> <p>What qualities do you think your friends admire in you?</p> <p><b>Listening is an important part of friendship</b></p> <p>How do you really listen? Mathematics	<p>Find a timetable which includes digital timings, for example; a train schedule. Covert some of these into an analogue format.</p> <p>Challenge: ask an adult to mix the schedule up. Can you put the timings back into the correct order?</p>	<p>Choose a day and create a log of your activities. This could be in the form of a comic strip, booklet or a diary.</p> <p>Include timings in analogue and digital formats.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Challenge: include intervals of 15 minutes</p>
English	<p>Challenge yourself to find a story from another culture that you have never read before.</p> <p>For example: have you heard of Anansi the Spider, if not you could find it and read it. If you have find another.</p> <p>Can you reimagine your chosen story from the perspective of a character from a different book? For example Akeyo from Handa's Surprise.</p> <p>This could take the form of a storyboard, story map or booklet.</p>	



Physical Education

Using a series of body shapes, can you create a routine that spells out your name in capital letters? This could include partner work. These will be shared during a PE session where you can coach and teach a friend to re-create your moves.

Challenge: Can you include a jump, a roll and a turn to connect your body shapes.
