


PSE	<p>Make an 'All About Me' poster to share with your friends.</p> <p>Include information such as your favourite things such as books, colours and games; maybe try and include what makes you happy and sad too.</p>	<p>Read the story Have you filled a bucket today?</p>  <p>Using a bucket outline can you draw or write some of the kind behaviours you have shown to fill another's bucket.</p>	
Mathematic	<p>Play simple games that follow a track, such as Snakes and Ladders and Ludo.</p> <p>Challenge: roll two dice, record the numbers and add them together.</p>	<p>How tall you are? Measure your height using object around your home. Can you find a combination of objects that measures the same as your height?</p> <p>Challenge: What if you could only use three objects?</p>	<p>Find a range of different sized shoes and measure their lengths in centimetres. Make a table comparing shoe size to length of shoe. Use this to make some predictions? How long would a size 7 shoe be?</p> <p>Challenge: Imagine a giants shoe is size 24, what would be the length?</p>
English	<p>This term we are exploring stories from around the world. Can you create a setting picture from story which represents a chosen part of the world? Think about the natural features, weather and animals found there.</p> 		<p>Can you create a short story, including pictures, set in a chosen part of the world.</p> <p>You could adapt a well-known story to make it your own. For example; by changing the animals, people or food encountered.</p>
