We deliver our Music Curriculum through an online scheme called 'Charanga', which is an award winning modern day resource for primary music. Charanga is a contemporary digital resource for music teachers and schools and provides exciting online learning for children and young people.



At Ewell Grove, we aim to give the children a varied range of experiences, which will stimulate their creativity and imagination. Throughout the year, we celebrate seasonal events such as Harvest, Christmas and spring, which always have a strong musical focus. We inspire the children to develop a love of music through listening to great composers and musicians across different genres, styles and traditions. The children will experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using musical dimensions such as pitch, tempo and duration. We have a growing collection of musical instruments, which enable the children to explore music from a wide range of cultures. We encourage the children to show expression allowing them to recognise and represent feelings and emotions in different ways.

In Key Stage 2, our children continue to build and consolidate their knowledge of interrelated dimensions of music. They will be creative and expressive whilst developing an understanding of musical composition through singing and playing a range of instruments, working collaboratively to become composers, performers and critiques. Children will develop their understanding of the theory of music by having the opportunity to explore historical pieces. There will be exciting opportunities to listen and appraise high quality live and recorded music.
