Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to announce that, from September 2019, Ewell Grove Primary and Nursery School will enter into a new partnership arrangement with Club Vale Limited (www.clubvale.co.uk) in regard to the provision of our Breakfast Club and After-School Club; opening is always subject to approval by OfSTED.

Club Vale Limited already has a highly regarded local reputation as a current provider of before and after provision to a number of Surrey Schools. This local experience along with their recognised OfSTED quality ratings, range of activities and commitment to safeguarding were fundamental in our decision. We were very grateful for the support we had, during our tendering process, by parents who are already users of our provision or plan to be once a space becomes available. All parents and carers, both existing and new, are now required to register with Club Vale Limited if they wish to enrol their child for Breakfast and/or After School Club. Please be aware that priority of Club places will initially be given to those children/families attending our current provision. This priority period will only run until 10th July, after which any available Club spaces will be allocated to new children/families.
