We created firework pictures using different media.



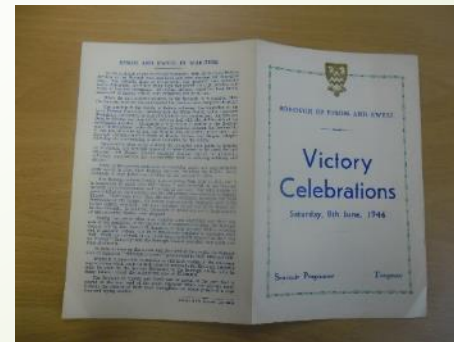
Remembrance is an important commemoration and we learned why poppies to help us remember.
