You can decide whether to have a hot school dinner, or bring your own packed lunch.



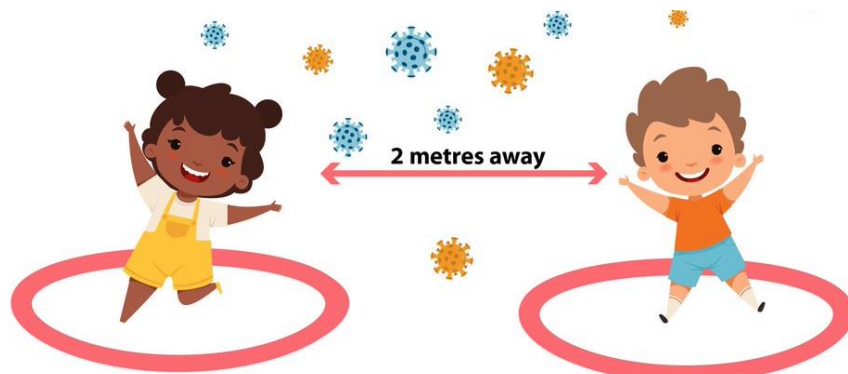
Playtimes will be on the playground and in the Orchard. These will be in year groups, you will have your playtime with Kite Class.

Wave



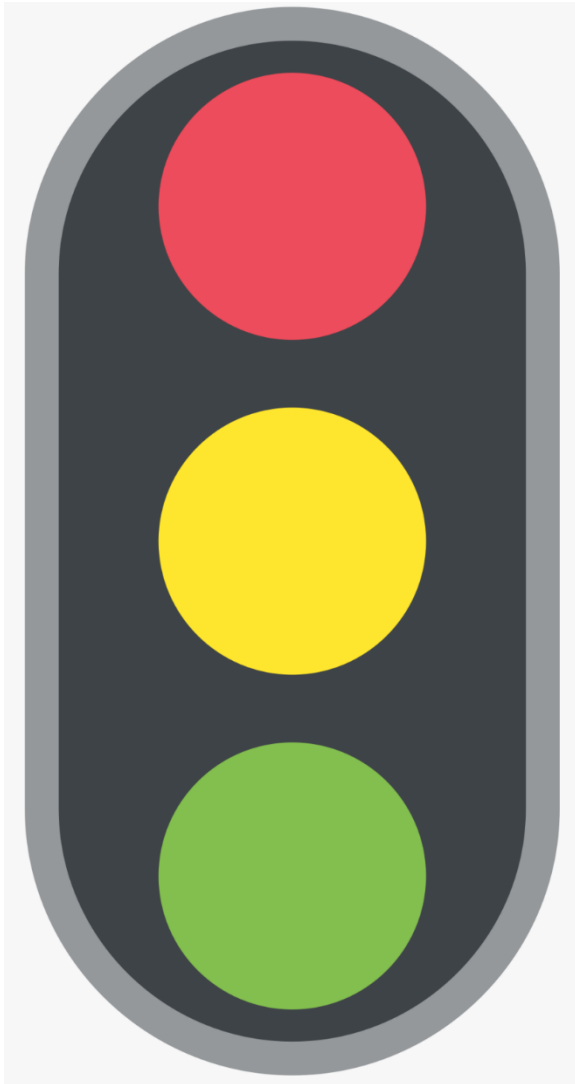

STOP!

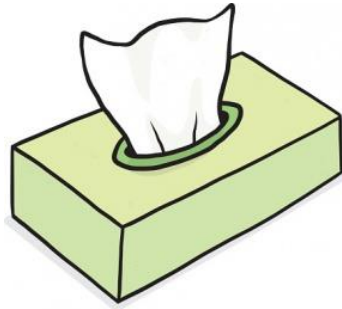


WASH
