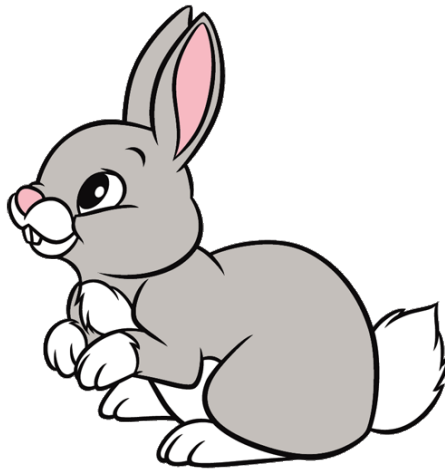




Rabbit Class

In Rabbit Class you will have stories from the Classroom Library and songs on the Interactive Board.

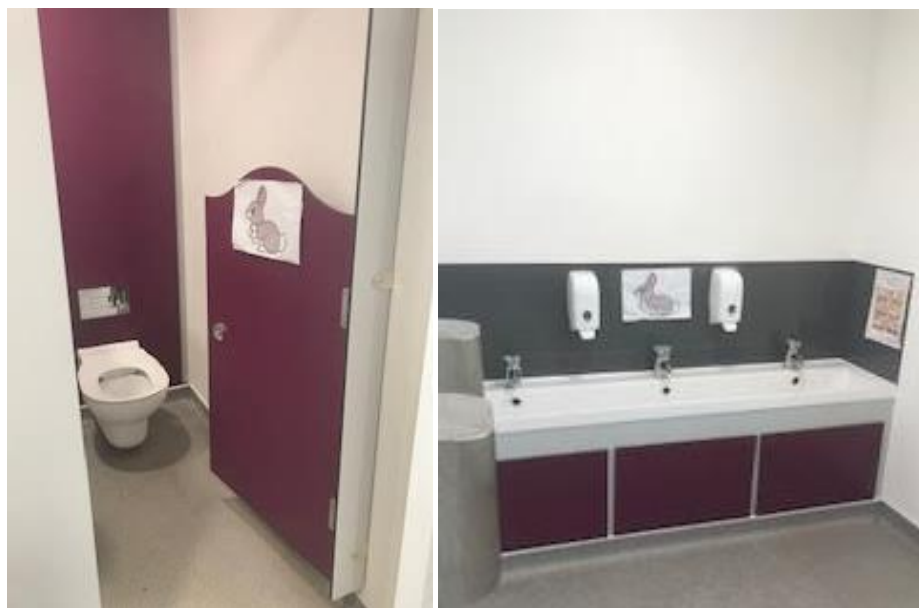

We will use pictures to help you know what activities are going to happen each day.

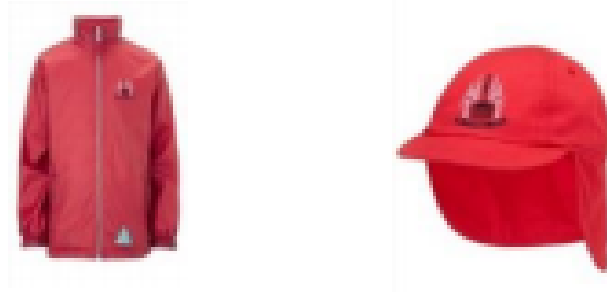


These are the Reception toilets, you will find a picture of a Rabbit on the doors to help you know which one to use.

From week two you will need to arrive at school in your PE kit and trainers on the days you have a sports session. Please leave your PE bag at home.



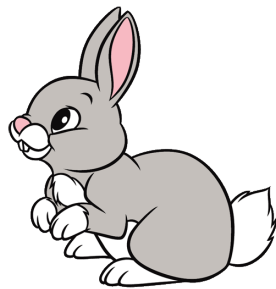
This is Gavin our Sports Coach.



You can decide whether to have a hot school dinner, or bring your own packed lunch.



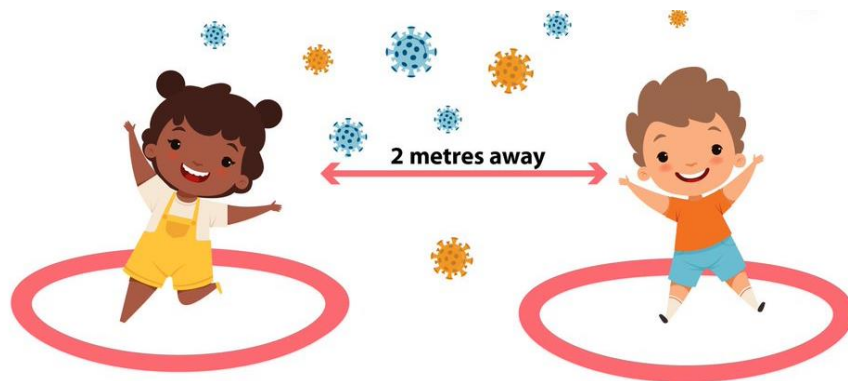
Playtimes will be on the playground and in the Orchard. These will be in year groups, you will have your playtime with Badger Class.

Wave



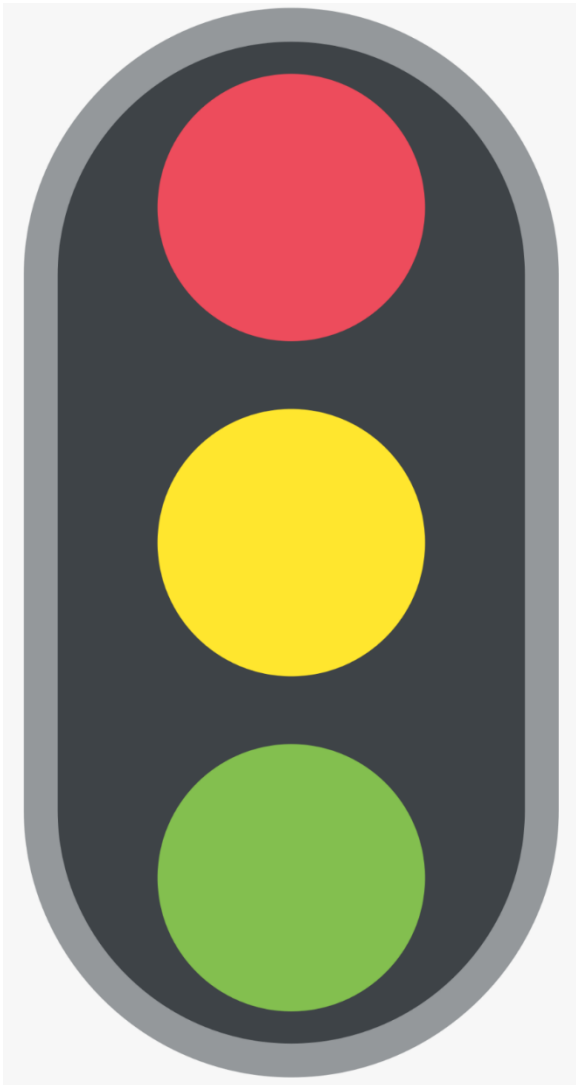
Smile

STOP!

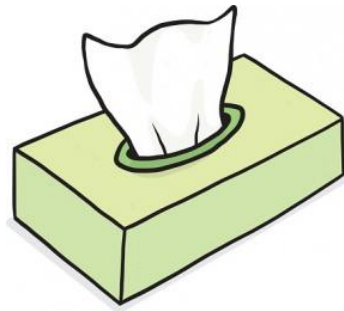


WASH
