Betty has worked hard to create a park piece of artwork. She took a step by step approach to paint the background, add the trees, then finally add Percy the Park Keeper and some animals.



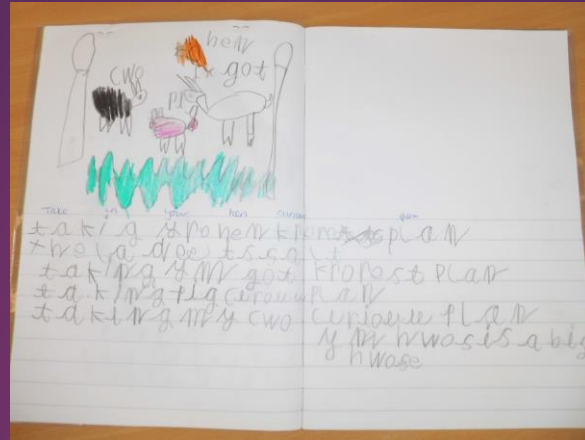
Squirrel Class
