



Having taken full advantage of recently available Government funding, Ewell Grove is excited to announce that we will be launching our new interactive learning platform, which uses Wonde and Google Classroom from today (Friday 25th September 2020).

Wonde acts as an additional protective layer between school data and educational apps by providing each child with a unique emoji password. Using this extra safeguarding tool our children will be able to log-in to educational apps and **Google Classroom** from a single sign-on. Google Classroom is our online learning platform, where the children will access assignments, submit work they have produced and enable the teacher to provide feedback. Wonde also allows single sign-on to our other online learning features such as, 'My Maths', 'Times Table Rock Stars' and 'Oxford Owl'. It is our intention to further develop this area to include other useful educational apps overtime.

The actual Gold Book Assembly will take place during the school day within classes and year groups. Unfortunately, parents cannot currently attend this event. Every Thursday the children due to be in Gold Book Assembly will take home a Gold Book certificate and on Friday their piece of work will be uploaded to Google Classroom . Your child can then celebrate their achievements with your family.

We will be using **Google Classroom** to immediately facilitate access to 'Remote Learning' for any individual or groups of children isolating at home – this will appear of Google Classroom under the Topic Folder 'Learning from Home'. If a child is isolating at home they will be expected to submit a piece of work every day. Learning from Home Feedback for any children isolating at home will be given within two days of the work being submitted.
