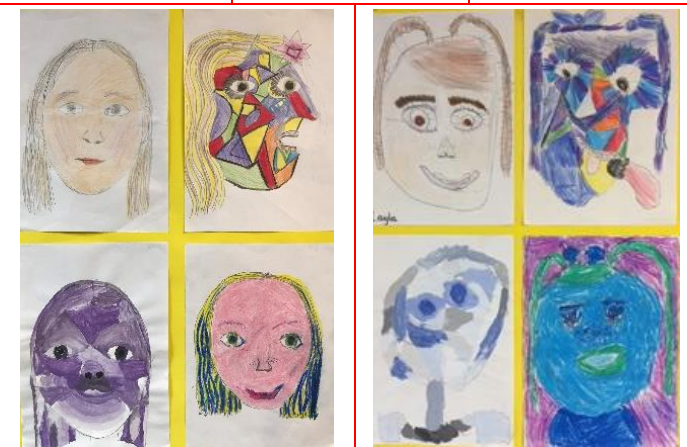
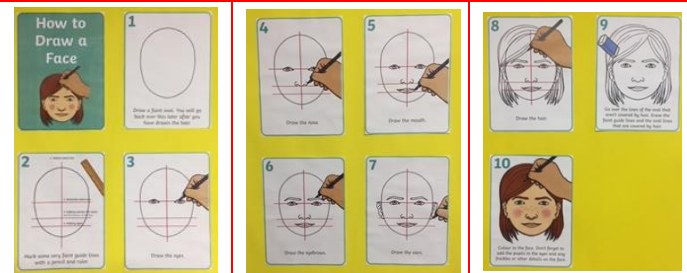

YEAR 4 ART FOCUS

Year 4 have focused on the influence the use of colour has in art and design; including considering the differing emotions this can evoke.

Using the work of significant artists Picasso, Paul Klee and Andy Warhol as stimuli, the children first learnt how to sketch realistic self-portraits by using a grid to place features in the correct place. Next they took one of the artists at a time and recreated their portrait using their specific artistic style. Over three weeks they repeated the process and I think you will agree the outcomes are excellent – well done!
