

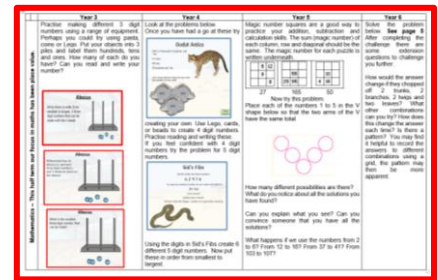
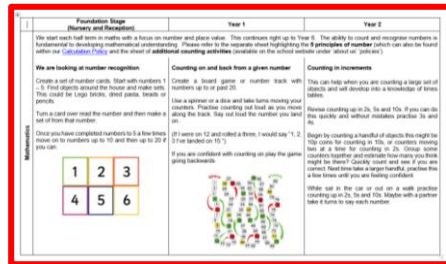


Whole School Home Learning

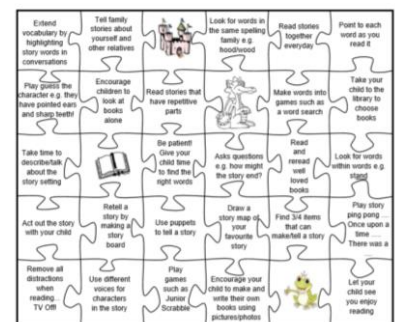
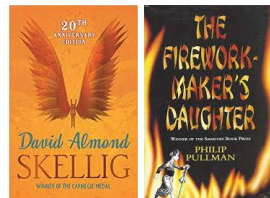
Instructions

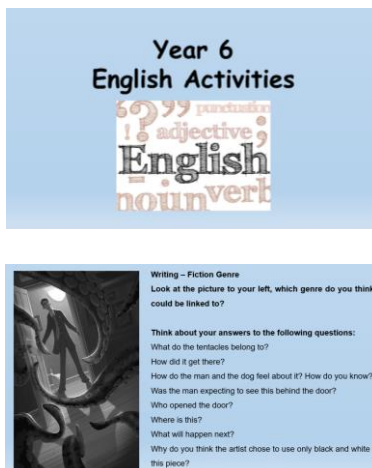

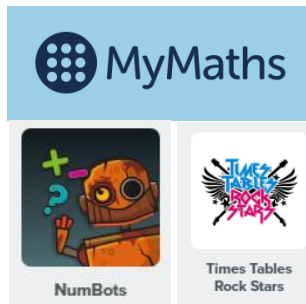
English and Phonics
