**EDUCATIONAL VISITS**

We are planning for our Year 1 and Year 2 children to be involved in two educational visits across the summer term.

**EWELL GROVE GAMES – FRIDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> JUNE**

Following the huge success of this event in previous years, we are delighted to inform you that we have organised the Ewell Grove Games 2022 to take place at the Harrier Centre during the afternoon of Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June. The children will enjoy an afternoon of Olympic themed activities such as relay, hurdles, javelin, shot putt, long jump and of course the well-known Olympic 'Egg & Spoon Race'. The children will be divided into colour teams and will be provided with a coloured sports vest. The winning team will be presented with the school trophy at the Award Ceremony.

The children will be transported to the Harrier Centre on coaches. Parents will be responsible for collecting their children from the Harrier Centre at the end of the afternoon at the normal school time of 3.05pm. Further information on this event will follow.

We would like to invite all families to join us at the Harrier Centre to encourage and support their children throughout the afternoon. This is an opportunity for the children to demonstrate the Olympic Values of Excellence, Friendship and Respect.

**PAINSHILL PARK – WEDNESDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> MAY**

We are delighted that we have been able to arrange an education visit to Painshill Park. This will provide the children with an exciting experience that cannot be offered within school. Over the spring term, the children have been exploring writing through traditional tales. The adventurous day will offer a 'Fairytale Story Walk' which will take them on a story walk through the magical Painshill landscape, past temples, towers and ruins. The children will be able to join in the storyteller's tale with drama, dance, games and amazing props. It will also include an 'Eye Spy Nature Trail' where the children will hunt high and low on Painshill's scavenger hunt challenges, building literacy and numeracy skills as well as encouraging friendship building. We will use coaches to transport children to and from Painshill Park.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £26.00 to cover the costs involved in both the Ewell Grove Games and the trip to Painshill Park. The cost of these events is calculated on the assumption that all children will participate. Unfortunately we are unable to refund the £26 if for any reason your child is unable to attend. If we receive insufficient voluntary contributions from families then these events will have to be cancelled as the school budget will not be used to subsidise these events.

Please make your payment and tick the **consent box**, using our secure scopay system, by no later than **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April** so we can ascertain if we have sufficient voluntary contributions for these educational visits to take place. For those children who are entitled to Pupil Premium the costs will be covered by the school however in order for your child to take part you will still need to tick the consent box online. Please contact the School Office if you have difficulty making the contribution towards the cost of these events.

Please note that should you choose for your child not to be involved in these events then they must attend school as usual and they will be accommodated in a different class.
