The focus on the learning this week will be friendship, and how these relationships should help us to feel happy and secure by giving:

- us a sense of belonging and community
- support when we need it and the ability to offer it to others when they do

We also teach that friendship is something that must be freely given, as people who ask us to do things in return for their friendship may not be real friends. Friendship is for sharing - trying to keep other people away from another relationship, for example out of jealousy, is more likely to make the friendship break down. People can end up feeling trapped or restricted and want to break away. All of the elements will be considered both in their 'real' and 'virtual' lives, so that positive principles can be equally applied to both.
