Friends of Ewell Grove are a friendly group of parents, carers, and teachers who raise money for the school, and as Ewell Grove families you are all automatically members. By working together, we can achieve the most benefit for the children, and so **building community** is an essential foundation to all the work we do: none of it happens without the goodwill of our volunteers! Volunteer with us

Extra pairs of hands are always welcome, however much time you can spare – thank you! This term we are trialling online sign-up sheets for volunteers; if you are able to help with any of the tasks below, please let us know via <u>volunteersignup.org/FPDMC</u>.

- Nearly New Uniform: Wednesday 6th September 8 9pm. Help sort donated uniform in the Orchard Room (the small building behind main school where after school club is held).
- **Welcome Picnic: Thursday 14**th **September.** Y1-Y6 parents/carers needed to set up (2.45-3.15pm), serve refreshments (3.30-4.30pm), and clear up. Children are welcome to help too.
- Coffee Morning: Friday 22nd September. Volunteers needed to set up (8.45-9.15am), serve refreshments (9.15-10.30am), and clear up at the end.

We are also seeking people to take on small organisational roles. The jobs can always be shared, so why not sign up with a friend? Please contact us (with no obligation!) to find out more.

- Raffle prize 'hunter': assist committee in liaising with businesses for raffle prize donations.
- Coffee morning co-ordinator: organise a speaker once per term and restock refreshments.
- Christmas cards co-ordinator: collate the children's artwork (completed in school) to send to the company, then organise distribution of orders back to classes upon delivery.
- Quizmaster: for our quiz night questions provided, or you could set the rounds as well.
- 'Chief Elf' (or Elves) Santa's postbox: responsible for liaising with the North Pole to ensure safe delivery of the children's letters to Santa and his replies back to school.

- **EasyFundraising:** sign up for a free account at <u>easyfundraising.org.uk</u>, nominate Ewell Grove as your chosen charity, and download the Donation Reminder (web browser plugin or via iPhone app) so that you can effortlessly generate donations for our school, at no added cost to yourself, whenever you shop online with over 7000 participating retailers.
