Dear Parents and Carers,

TAG RUGBY – YEAR 4

We are pleased to advise that during the Autumn Term we will be running a Tag Rugby Club for children in Year 4. This club will take place at **Old Schools Lane** from **3:00pm– 4:00pm**.

We will be focusing on skills of passing, dodging, tagging, working as a team and scoring as well as preparing for upcoming competitions.

As the children are already at Old School's Lane on a Thursday afternoon, we will be continuing our provision until 4:00pm for Tag Rugby Club. Children involved in Tag Rugby Club **will not** walk back to school after their P.E session; they will remain at Old School's Lane with a teacher. The children will eat a snack and have a drink. **To help us with this, please ensure your child has a healthy snack in their school bag to be eaten at this time. Please ensure this does not contain nuts.**

Please walk into Old Schools Lane, past the fields towards the court area, where the children will need to be collected at 4:00pm.

The total cost for these sessions will be £15 (£1.50 per session) which will cover the cost of sports equipment.

Please speak to your child **prior** to signing them up for Tag Rugby Club to ensure that it is something they really would like to do; by taking a place your child does not want, you may be preventing another child who would like to take part from participating in the initial essential sessions.

You will be sent a 'Form' today via a separate Parent Mail; if you would like your child to take part in Tag Rugby Club please complete this form by **10:30am on Friday 8th September**.

We will then notify you if your child has a place and will ask that you make your payment through Tucasi. For any child who is entitled to Pupil Premium; these costs will be covered by the school.
