This week we were excited with the delivery of our new school stage. We are looking forward to using it for nativities and Christmas performances in December.



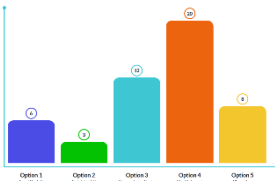
THE LITTLE RECYCLERS
