



**SUBJECT OF THE WEEK - SCIENCE**



Year 2 were looking at the effect that heat has on an object and if the experiment could also be reversible. We timed how long it took for the ice blocks to melt and compared the results with the other class. We then discussed how it wasn't a fair experiment as our variables were different.

The first class only used 2 ice cubes and their water was poured into the glass 5 minutes before starting, meaning it was warmer. The second class used 3 ice cubes and the water was poured 15 minutes before making it slightly cooler so it took longer for those cubes to melt. Year 2 said it is a reversible experiment as we could put the water back into the ice tray and back into the freezer to solidify again. You might like to try this activity at home.
