



Thank you for joining us this morning, it was lovely to come together as a whole school community. The sun was shining and the children sang brilliantly.

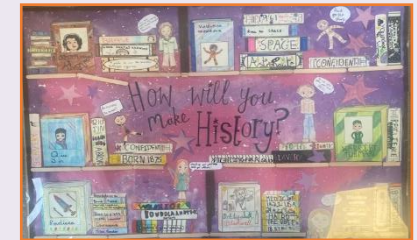
It was a great opportunity for them to share our whole School focus on a “sense of belonging” and the Fundamental British Values which are:
